Titel	Contemporary patient-oriented interdisciplinary treatment from adolescence to adulthood <ul style="list-style-type: none">- The smile as an obligation to our patients (Cocconi and Perakis)- Missing Teeth in the Smile Area: Space Closure and Orthodontic Management of the Periodontal Tissues (Rosa)
Abstract Cocconi Perakis	<p>Our adolescent patients with congenitally missing teeth require contemporary solutions that can be functionally valid and esthetically pleasing long term. Implant in the esthetic zone present significant limitations and their application should be postponed. Therefore new strategies should be applied to our patients in the difficult transition from adolescence to adulthood.</p> <p>The digital technology can be used as a GPS in designing a multidisciplinary treatment that involves orthodontics and restorative dentistry. A proper hierarchy of decisions and responsibilities need to be defined. Form is everything but position and size. For this reason the orthodontist first needs to set up the proper occlusion deciding the position and the available size that will be necessary for the restorative dentist to obtain the proper form with a minimally invasive preparation. Several cases will illustrate the step-by-step approach and all the clinical issues of the treatment, from diagnosis to orthodontic guided position of Tads, materials of choice and laminate veneers realization passing through all the interactions between the dental team members explaining who does what and when and proposing a clear hierarchy of decision. A review of digital and classical possibilities for the realization of laminate veneers is proposed with its pros and cons.</p>
Abstract Rosa	<p>In patients with maxillary missing incisors, the space closure alternative may be the best alternative and the first step of an interdisciplinary treatment, which leads to long term health, aesthetic and function. Space closure looking for excellence is now not only possible in all malocclusions, but also is an evidence based treatment. The lecture will show and discuss the rationale, the clinical method and crucial details of this treatment.</p> <p>PARTICIPANTS WILL LEARN</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Guidelines to plan the interdisciplinary (ortho/perio/prosthodont) treatment in case of missing teeth in the smile area.- Rationale for the Space Closure in CMLI patients.- New scientific evidence.- New tricks and tips to optimize treatment and prevent negative side effects.- How to close the spaces in all malocclusion.- New alternatives for cosmetic restorations of the front teeth.- New alternatives of prosthetic replacement in the smile area.- What periodontal tissue reaction is to be expected following intrusion and extrusion in case of severe periodontal breakdown.

Renato Cocconi MD, MS, is an orthodontist in Parma, Italy where he belongs to the FACE Ortho Surgical Center, a private practice that he directs with Prof. Raffaini. Dr Cocconi attended a 3 year Postgraduate Program in Orthodontics at the Department of Orthodontics of the University of Milan where he obtained his master's degree in 1993. He subsequently spent 3 years in the United States where he worked in L.F. Andrews and attended the Roth Williams postgraduate course in from 1991-1993. Since that time Dr Cocconi has been very active in the orthodontic community nationally and internationally. He has received countless invitations to speak internationally for such groups as AAO, European Orthodontic Society, the American Academy of Esthetic Dentistry, the European Academy of Esthetic Dentistry and the World Orthodontic Meeting in London in September 2015. He is a Active member of the Angle Society of Europe and an active member of the European Academy of Esthetic Dentistry. He has served as a clinical professor in the Department of Orthodontics of the University of Milan from 1993 to 2008. Currently, Cocconi is a practicing partner in the FACE group in Italy and Europe and is also active member in many organizations including the EOS, AAO, SIDO and the Angle Society of Europe.

Nikolaos Perakis graduated in dentistry with first class honours at the University of Bologna (Italy).
