Titel	TERMINAL DENTITION – Where do we draw the line?
Abstract	<p>For over a decade, the term “Terminal Dentition”, has unquestionably gained a lot of traction in the dental world, and it implies that there is a need to remove a patient’s remaining dentition. But how do we reach such stage or conclusion? And, does it mean the same to everybody?</p> <p>The reality is that the term Terminal Dentition is actually a “dentist made term”.</p> <p>Of the same token, until this day, there seems to be confusion among dental practitioners as to what is the ideal prosthetic solution for these patients.</p> <p>This presentation will discuss a linear thought process that allows the treating team to decide when to choose to give up hope on the remaining dentition and how to decide among the different restorative designs available.</p> <p>The course will also have a team integration component that will allow the interdisciplinary team, to work closely into developing a more integral communication protocol. This unquestionably represents a prerequisite for long term success.</p>

Curriculum	<p>Dr. Ricardo Mitrani, received his DDS degree from the Unitec University of México City; a certificate in Prosthodontics as well as a Master of Science in Dentistry from the University of Washington, where he served as the Graduate Prosthodontics program’s assistant director during the year of 2001.</p> <p>He currently holds academic affiliations at the University of Washington, and is a resident faculty at SPEAR Education in Scottsdale Arizona</p> <p>He is a member of several organizations including the American Academy of Esthetic Dentistry and the American Academy of Restorative Dentistry.</p> <p>He is part of the editorial board of the Journal of Esthetic and Restorative Dentistry (JERD), The Journal of Cosmetic Dentistry (JCD) and Compendium, as well as the Executive director of Spear Digest.</p> <p>Dr Mitrani has authored numerous scientific publications and chapters in textbooks in the fields of Implant Prosthodontics and Aesthetic dentistry and has given over 600 lectures around the globe, maintaining a private practice limited to Prosthodontics, Implants and Aesthetic dentistry in Mexico City.</p> <p>Dr. Jack Goldberg received his dental degree from the Technological University of Mexico in 2011. Dr. Goldberg continued at the USC School of Dentistry with a 3 year full time residency in the specialty of advanced prosthodontics, receiving his Prosthodontics Certificate in 2014, then he earned a Masters of Science in Orofacial Pain and Oral Medicine at the University of Southern California. Dr. Goldberg’s completed a 1 year surgical fellowship program in implant dentistry at the University of Louisville, Kentucky. Presently, he works together with his partner Dr. Ricardo Mitrani in private practice in Mexico City.</p>
